When will DR Congo's solar power plants be built?

The plants are to be built by the Moyi Power joint venture and are expected to be completed within 18 months after the start of construction. According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020.

What is a 10 MW solar power plant?

Imagine a vast area, typically the size of about 40 football fields, lined meticulously with rows of gleaming solar panels--this is what encompasses a 10 MW solar power plant. Such a facility is capable of producing enough electricity to power approximately 2,000 average homes, making it a significant contributor to local energy needs.

How much power does DR Congo have?

According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020. The country has one of the lowest levels of access to electricity in the world, with only 9% of the population being supplied with power. This percentage in rural areas drops to as far as 1%.
