The creation of a new privately-owned and operated electricity distribution company that will bring grid power to almost 70% of Burundi's population was announced at the Africa Climate Summit in Nairobi today.

Burundi's first utility-scale power development to come online in over three decades started up in October. The 7.5MW Mubuga solar PV plant will boost the country's on-grid generation capacity by just over 10%, according to African Energy Live Data.

Burundi, where about 10% of the population has access to electricity, will see the expansion of its power-distribution grid from next year, boosted by \$1.4 billion of funding from international ...

The Mubuga Solar Power Station is a grid-connected 7.5 MW solar power plant in Burundi. The power station was constructed between January 2020 and October 2021, by Gigawatt Global Co., a Dutch company, the Netherlands-based multinational independent power producer (IPP), through its local subsidiary Gigawatt Global Burundi SA. The off-taker for this power station is the Government of Burundi.

Its portfolio of projects includes: Zengamina, a hydro-powered utility in Zambia; Songa Energy, an operator of two grid-connected hydropower plants in Burundi; and Weza Power, a new private sector utility formed in partnership with the Government of Burundi.
