This page is part of Global Energy Monitor 's Latin America Energy Portal. As of 2020,Barbados derived 93% of its electricity from fossil fuels, with the remaining 7% generated by solar energy.

Who is responsible for energy generation in Barbados?

MEWR (Ministry of Energy and Water Resources) is responsible for energy generation in Barbados. The Ministry of Environment and National Beautification oversees environmental protection through permitting. The Project Monitoring & Coordination Team ensures energy projects align with the BNEP 2019-2030.

What is the Barbados national energy policy (BNEP)?

This Barbados National Energy Policy (BNEP) document is designed to achieve the 100% renewable energy and carbon neutral island- state transformational goals by 2030. These include: Provision of reliable, safe, affordable, sustainable, modern and climate friendly energy services to all residents and visitors.

Who regulates the energy industry in Barbados?

The Ministry of Environment and National Beautification regulates the energy industry by ensuring environmental protections. The Barbados Fair Trading Commission is another regulatory entity. Mining regulation is overseen by the Geology and Mining Department.

Who provides electricity in Barbados?

Electricity in Barbados is entirely supplied by the Barbados Light and Power Company (BL&P). They operate the thermal generation, transmission, and distribution systems on the island.

Is biomass a source of electricity in Barbados?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal,crop waste,and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Barbados: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power?
