Will Europe's first lithium-ion battery cell Gigafactory be financed?

The European Investment Bank (EIB) has agreed in principle to provide EUR 350 million in financing to support Northvolt's development of Europe's first lithium-ion battery cell gigafactory. The factory in Sweden will help reduce the EU's dependence on oil and imported batteries.

Where are Svalbard and Jan Mayen located?

The islands are located north and northwest of Norway, within the southern limits of Arctic sea ice -- the northernmost point of Svalbard is within a 620 mi (1,000 km) of the North Pole. Svalbard is approximately 24,570 square mi (63,000 square km); Jan Mayen is approximately 145 square mi (373 square km).

Will a Swedish battery factory reduce EU dependence on oil and imported batteries?

The factory in Sweden will help reduce the EU's dependence on oil and imported batteries. The support follows an EIB loan to the Swedish company guaranteed by the InnovFin-EU finance for innovators initiative to build a battery demonstration plant.

What is Northvolt doing to increase European battery production?

Northvolt is contributing to the much-needed increase in European battery production with its construction of the Northvolt Ett lithium-ion battery cell factory in Skellefteå, north-east Sweden, which will employ some 2 500 people.

Will battery Gigafactory projects be delayed?

Analysts predict that many battery gigafactory projects in Europe are likely to be delayed. CATL announced a second facility this week.

Are batteries a strategic component of European competitiveness?

'Batteries are a strategic component of European competitiveness and to capture a new European market worth EUR 250 billion annually as of 2025, we need to act fast,' says Maro Tóth, European Commission Vice-President for the Energy Union, in announcing the financing.

Metal-hydrogen battery company EnerVenue will open a manufacturing factory with a 1GWh annual capacity in Kentucky expected to begin production by the end of the year. The company expects to invest upwards of US\$1 billion to expand to more than 20GWh of annual manufacturing capacity across its domestic manufacturing sites in subsequent phases.
