What is Tata Power doing in Bhutan?

Tata Power has joined forces with Druk Green Power Corp. to develop 5,000 MW of clean energy capacity in Bhutan. This includes large-scale hydropower and solar projects aimed at supporting Bhutan's energy goals and regional integration.

Who is developing a 500 MW solar project in Bhutan?

Another 500 MW of solar projects will be developed by Tata Power Renewable Energy Ltd., a subsidiary of Tata Power, it said. This partnership aligns with Bhutan's vision for its energy sector, which aims to increase its overall generation capacity to 25,000 MW by 2040, ensuring energy security and promoting regional energy integration.

Will Bhutan's Clean Power Project help India's transition to renewables?

While the clean power from the project will help meet Bhutan's increasing electricity requirements, it will also complement and contribute to India's energy transition to renewables. The partnership involves a 40% equity investment by Tata Power in the Public Private Partnership Company, Khorlochhu Hydro Power Limited.

How much does it cost to build a hydropower project in Bhutan?

Tata Power and Druk Green Power Corporation are building a 600 MW hydropower project in Bhutan. The project will cost Rs 6,900 crore. It will be operational by September 2029. Another 1,125 MW project is also planned. This partnership aims to develop 5,000 MW of clean energy capacity in Bhutan. Work on the second project will begin in January 2025.

Why does Bhutan need hydropower?

More importantly, Bhutan sees its hydropower as critical in ensuring round-the-clock availability of power with India's huge investments in renewables such as solar and wind and the plans to further accelerate investments in these renewables over the next two decades.

Earlier this month, Aura Power received planning permission from Darlington Council for its 49.9 MW Burtree Lane solar farm. Similarly to its other projects, the Grimsby solar farm will offer ecological enhancements which, the company anticipates, will boost biodiversity by over 71% over baseline conditions.
