Does Cambodia export solar panels?

In 2022, Cambodia's solar panel exports soared by 2.8 times year-on-year to USD1.0 billion; the share of solar panel exports to the country's total exports rose to 4.6 percent from 1.4 percent.

Does Cambodia have solar power?

However, considering the country's historical energy mix, the existing solar capacity appears positive. As of 2011, Cambodia had no solar power plants, and solar energy was not a part of the country's energy mix. Cambodia's current installed solar capacity is slightly over 400 MW, but the country is targeting 3.1 GW by 2040.

Why are solar panels becoming a trend in Cambodia?

However, a new trend in the country's exports has emerged in the past two years - a sharp increase in electrical and electronics (E&E) manufacturing products, particularly solar panels.

With these opportunities in mind,the government has set ambitious targets for expanding solar energy in Cambodia, aiming to inject 2 GW of solar energy into the grid by 2030. This goal is supported by a range of policies designed to facilitate the growth of the solar sector, including incentives for investment and development.

Why did Cambodia's solar panel exports decline in 2024?

As a result, Cambodia's exports experienced a significant drop in the early months of 2024, with similar declines seen in Malaysia, Thailand, and Vietnam. Domestically, Cambodia's solar panel industry is confronted by challenges from unstable electricity supply and high transportation costs.
