

# Can a locker be placed inside a fish tank

Where should a fish tank be kept?

You should keep your tank somewhere accessible. It must be in a place that's easy for you to reach. You definitely don't want your aquarium to be encased or tucked away on a tall shelf. There should be enough space for you to reach around the sides and in the back of the aquarium.

Never put a fish tank on a piece of standard household furniture. Regular furniture is not built to take that amount of weight and may collapse under the strain.
