What is a solar panel warranty?

Solar panel warranties vary by manufacturer and type of panel. A standard solar panel warranty should come with at least 10 years of protection. Solar panel warranties typically won't reimburse for labor costs associated with installing new equipment or shipping fees for new equipment.
