How to put a lock in a locker?

To install an 'extra' Godrej lock in a locker, first insert the key in the lock's keyhole (located at the bottom left). Then, you can put the lock in the bank of the locker and install it with screws there.

How do I choose a locker?

You also need to consider the position of any windows or doors. Make sure your lockers will not block access to any windows or doors which still need to be opened. Take note of things like skirting boards, radiators, heating pipes, light switches, and sockets etc. Make sure you install on a strong, level and even surface, are the floors level?

Should you bring a lock to a locker room?

" We have TV lounges in our locker room and 99% of the guys sit there with towels on, " he says. " But you sometimes get the one-off guy who sits there without it. How do you secure a locker?

A single run of lockers must be secured to a suitable anchor point with a suitable bracing mechanism. Lockers on stands or seat/stands should be fixed down to the stand or seat/stand as well as side to side and back to a wall or run of lockers.

How do I use the locker room?

To use the locker room at the Keon Testing Center, place your quarter (s) in the slot located inside the locker door, close the door, turn the key to the left, and pull the key out. If you have any issues opening your locker, please notify the Testing Center manager and they can assist you. The Testing Center does not operate the locker room.

How wide should a locker be?
