

# China's solar power generation situation

How much solar power does China have in 2023?

China added almost twice as much utility-scale solar and wind power capacity in 2023 than in any other year. By the first quarter of 2024, China's total utility-scale solar and wind capacity reached 758 GW, though data from China Electricity Council put the total capacity, including distributed solar, at 1,120 GW.

Can China make more solar power?

China can now make more solar power than the rest of the world. Data released by China's National Agency last week revealed that the country's solar electric power generation capacity grew by a staggering 55.2 percent in 2023. The numbers highlight over 216 gigawatts (GW) of solar power China built during the year.

How big is China's power generation capacity in 2023?

China's overall power generation capacity grew by 13.9% over the course of 2023 to reach a total of 2919 GW. Alongside new solar projects, the country's wind power generation capacity jumped by 20.7%, the data showed.

When will China reach 200GW of wind & solar capacity?

By the end of April 2024, China total installed wind + solar capacity reached 1129GW. If this pace sustains or accelerates in the rest of the year, China will achieve its 200GW of installed wind and solar capacity by 2030 target this year, 6 years ahead of time. Zero e
