

How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI - Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two - West Island and Home Island - are inhabited.

How long will Cocos Keeling Island be under water?

Inundation studies of Cocos Keeling Islands predict the atoll could be under water in 50 or 60 years. For now, sandbags provided by the Commonwealth hold back the water on both Home Island and West Island. During cyclone season, roads in the kampong on Home Island are often inundated and houses can be thigh-deep in saltwater.

Why are Christmas & Cocos Keeling Islands so important?

In March 2022, Christmas and Cocos Keeling islands were declared one of the largest marine sanctuary areas in the world. But Dr Whiting says despite the importance of the turtle population to the region, he thinks it's a case of out of sight, out of mind.
