

What is Colombia's energy policy?

Since August 2022, Colombia's energy policy under President Gustavo Petro has called for increased development of renewable energy sources and reduced economic dependence on fossil fuels. The MME (Ministerio de Minas y Energí#a), formed in 1974, oversees Colombia's mining industry, mineral industry, and electricity sector.

Why does Colombia have a poor energy sector?

Lack of accountability in the Colombian energy sector allows for problematic outcomes. The gaseous nature of coal deposits in Colombia has caused a large number of occupational accidents and deaths. Poor ventilation, poor worker training, and inadequate regulation are all factors in methane-related accidents.

What is Colombia's energy transition process?

Colombia's energy transition process is underway. Former President Ivan Duque set a goal to increase non-conventional renewable energy installed capacity from one percent to more than 12 percent of the energy matrix by 2022.

Does Colombia export steam coal to the Pacific?

At the same time, several factors speak against major exports of Colombian steam coal to the Pacific market. Currently it is dominated by Indonesia and - to a lesser extent - Australia, which can supply coal to China at lower costs than Colombia.

Is Colombia a good country for hydroelectric power?

With high rainfall rates and a topography favorable for hydroelectric power projects, Colombia has developed hydro as its primary source of electricity, comprising two-thirds of installed capacity and electrical generation in 2020.

Can Colombian high-quality coal be used in high-efficiency power plants?

Colombian high-quality coal is compatible with modern high-efficiency power plants. Coal from Indonesia and South Africa on average is of lower quality and would need further preparation and beneficiation before it could substitute for Colombian coal in high-efficiency supercritical and ultra-supercritical boilers.
