

Is the Falklands Islands company still a part of the group?

Despite this change of name, the Group's Falklands business, the Falklands Islands Company ("FIC"), remains a core part of the Group. The Falkland Islands Company (FIC) was incorporated in 1851 and received its Royal Charter on 10 January 1852.

Who owns the Falklands Conservation Zone?

FIC acquired by The Dundee Perth and London Shipping Company Limited which is itself purchased by Coalite Group PLC. Argentina invades the Falkland Islands and occupies the islands for 74 days.
