

# Gabon energy saving products

What are the main sources of energy in Gabon?

(October 2009) Energy in Gabon comes from two main sources, fossil-fuels and hydroelectricity. Gabon also relies heavily on oil for its export revenues, exporting both crude oil and petroleum. In terms of its oil reserves, the country is one of the richest in sub-Saharan Africa, ranking 5th after Nigeria, Angola, Sudan, South Sudan, and Uganda.

How much electricity does Gabon produce?

Gabon's total electricity production in 2015 was 199 kilotonne of oil equivalent (ktoe), with 51.7% produced from hydropower sources and 48.2% from fossil fuels. The country's final consumption of electricity was 169 ktoe.

Is biomass a source of electricity in Gabon?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Gabon: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.

Why is Gabon a good country?

Gabon also relies heavily on oil for its export revenues, exporting both crude oil and petroleum. In terms of its oil reserves, the country is one of the richest in sub-Saharan Africa, ranking 5th after Nigeria, Angola, Sudan, South Sudan, and Uganda. Renewable energy in the form of solar power is virtually nonexistent.

Who controls the oil industry in Gabon?

The government of Gabon controls all petroleum and mineral rights within the state. In 2011 a presidential decree created the Gabon Oil Company (GOC). This new entity works in partnership with international companies operating in Gabon and operates two fields: Obangue and Remboue.

Is Gabon a member of OPEC?

Gabon, a former OPEC member (1975-1994) that rejoined in 2016, is the sixth-largest oil producer in sub-Saharan Africa. The first national oil company was the Soci t  Nationale Petroli re Gabonaise but it was disbanded in 1987. The government of Gabon controls all petroleum and mineral rights within the state.

production, transmission and supply of electricity and drinking water. The country has officially withdrawn the exclusivity of the services granted to the concessionaire, opening ...

It also includes non-energy uses of energy products, such as fossil fuels used to make chemicals. Gabon CO<sub>2</sub> Fuel Combustion/CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions. In its NDC (2016), Gabon set the commitment to reduce its GHG emissions by at least 50% in 2025 as compared to a BAU scenario, including LULUCF (Land Use, Land-Use Change and Forestry), which accounts for more than 60% of direct emissions, but excluding carbon stocks in forests (i.e. sinks).

AFREC 2020 energy balance shows that Gabon produced 9,008 ktoe of crude oil and exported about 90% of this production. Total primary energy supply in 2018 was 6,220 ktoe. The fuel share of TFC in Gabon are biomass 84%, oil and petroleum products 12%, and electricity 4%.
