

Why do German companies want to invest in African energy?

Many German companies are keen to finance African initiatives to produce hydrogen energy for export to Europe. And African nations are also keen to power up using gas. They see it as a transitional fuel because natural gas produces lower carbon emissions than fossil fuels like oil and coal.

Should Africa support energy development projects?

Energy development projects are capital-intensive and require private-public partnerships, according to Ethiopia's energy minister, Sultan Wali. "African governments cannot carry out these projects alone," Wali said. "They need financial support from Germany and other rich western countries.
