

# Government solar scheme Zimbabwe

How many solar power projects are there in Zimbabwe?

As of 31 July 2019, the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) had issued more than 77 power generation licences with 42 being solar power projects. A number of IPPs are already selling electricity to the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC) and feeding into the national grid.

Should Zimbabwe invest in solar power?

Interest in investing in Zimbabwe's solar power market is on the rise as the Ministry approves 39 solar PV projects for development. The Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (Zera) has processed 39 solar power projects that have capacity to generate up to 1,151.87MW, as the country moves towards renewable energy to increase capacity.

Could solar power be cheaper in Zimbabwe?

Zimbabwe has enough solar power to support these. These solar systems could be made cheaper through the introduction of subsidies and tax incentives. Even better, the government could waive taxes on all certified systems coming into the country. And more needs to be done to publicise the use of gas in urban and rural households.

Can solar power improve health in Zimbabwe?

The most popular and most purchased solar panels are Canadian solar panels.
