Will ExxonMobil deliver natural gas to Guyana by 2024?

ExxonMobil is on track to deliver natural gas from its offshore Guyana operations to the mainland by the end of 2024. This Gas-to-Energy (GtE) Project aims to construct an Integrated Natural Gas Liquid (NGL) plant and a 300-megawatt (MW) combined cycle power plant at Wales, West Bank Demerara (WBD).

Did Exxon Mobil & totalenergies bid on Guyana oil & gas?

Guyana on Wednesday received bids for eight of 14 offshore oil and gas exploration blocks offered in its first auction, including from groups formed by Exxon Mobil and TotalEnergies, according to the government and documents seen by Reuters.

Will Guyana's strategic objective be achieved?

"The government's strategic objective to lessen the influence by the major players already active in the country looks unlikely to be achieved," he said.
