Heard Island and McDonald Islands are located in the Southern Ocean, approximately 1,700 km from the Antarctic continent and 4,100 km south-west of Perth. As the only volcanically active subantarctic islands they "open a window into the earth", thus providing the opportunity to observe ongoing geomorphic processes and glacial dynamics. ...

McDonald Island is much smaller (2.5 km 2), about 100 000 years old and totally ice-free, and is predominantly composed of phonolitic rocks. 9, 10 During the campaign, signs of volcanic activity ...

Mawson Peak on Heard Island is the highest Australian mountain (at 2,745 meters, it is taller than Mt. Kosciuszko in Australia proper), and one of only two active volcanoes located in Australian territory, the other being McDonald Island; in 1992, McDonald Island broke its dormancy and began erupting; it has erupted several times since, most ...

Heard Island and McDonald Islands are uninhabited, barren, Subantarctic islands in the Southern Ocean, far due south of India and roughly 400 km southeast of Kerguelen of the French Southern and Antarctic Lands. The McDonald Islands archipelago is a group of small, rocky volcanic islands that are situated approximately 44km to the west of Heard Island. The archipelago comprises McDonald Island, Flat Island, and Meyer Rock which collectively occupy an area of 2.5 sq. km.

Discovered in 1854 by Captain McDonald the islands were positioned by sightings from Heard Island in 1948 and shown as 5 separate islands on chart AUS 08 published in 1949. In 1971 a sketch map was drawn by Natmap following a visit by the French ship Gallieni compiled from hand held oblique photography taken from a helicopter.
