How do you store boxed milk?

Location: Situate your boxed milk away from any sources of heat or light. Once a carton of shelf-stable milk is opened, it requires refrigeration. Place the open carton in the refrigerator and consume it within 5 to 7 days for best quality. Keep the temperature of the refrigerator below 40°F (4°C) to ensure safety and maintain freshness.

How long does shelf-stable milk last?

While refrigerated milk typically expires within a couple of weeks, shelf-stable milk can last unopened for six to nine monthsat room temperature without spoiling. This extended longevity can lead to reduced food waste, as the milk is less likely to spoil before it can be used. The environment benefits from the attributes of shelf-stable milk.

Where should milk be stored?

Storage practices impact the milk's longevity; it is best to store milk at the back of the refrigeratoron a lower or middle shelf where temperatures are typically coldest, rather than on the door which experiences more temperature fluctuation. Following these guidelines ensures the milk stays fresh and safe for as long as possible.

How do you store unused milk?

Keep the lids on the bottle. Tightly screw the lid on so that the milk doesn't absorb any odours from strong smelling food. If you want to be extra careful store the milk separately from other foods. Never return unused milk back into the original bottle. Once it spends any time at room temperature, milk spoils quickly.
