How long can breast milk be stored?

Never store breast milk in disposable bottle liners or plastic bags that are not intended for storing breast milk. Freshly expressed or pumped milk can be stored: At room temperature (77°F or colder) for up to 4 hours. In the refrigerator for up to 4 days. In the freezer for about 6 months is best; up to 12 months is acceptable.

How long can milk be stored?

Milk can be stored: Up to four days in a standard refrigerator. Up to three to four months inside a standard refrigerator freezer. Up to six to 12 months in a separate deep freezer. In an insulated cooler bag with frozen ice packs for up to 24 hours while traveling.

How long can pumped milk be stored?

Freshly expressed or pumped milk can be stored: At room temperature (77°F or colder) for up to 4 hours. In the refrigerator for up to 4 days. In the freezer for about 6 months is best; up to 12 months is acceptable. Recommended storage times are important to follow for best quality. Want to learn more?

Can breast milk be stored in the refrigerator or freezer?

Do not store breast milk in the door of the refrigerator or freezer. Storing it further inside will help protect the breast milk from temperature changes when the door opens and closes. If you don't think you will use freshly expressed breast milk within 4 days, freeze it right away. This will help to protect the quality of the breast milk.

How do you store breast milk in a container?

Containers you can use to store milk include: Glass is the first choice for breast milk storage. It preserves the components of milk the best. But glass breaks, so keep in mind that some daycare centers won't allow it. Hard-sided plastic containers are the second-choice alternative for breast milk storage.

How long can you keep frozen breast milk?

However, using the frozen milk within six months is optimal. Keep in mind that research suggests that the longer you store breast milk -- whether in the refrigerator or in the freezer -- the greater the loss of vitamin C in the milk. It's also important to note that your breast milk changes to meet your baby's needs.

Technically, frozen food will last forever if stored at 0°F. However, we're only talking about the safety here; foods will not be dangerous to eat. However, food is all about taste. The food's color, flavor, and texture will start to deteriorate.

Once previously frozen breast milk is thawed, it can be stored in the fridge and must be used within 24 hours.

Freshly pumped breast milk can be stored at room temperature (no warmer than 77°F) for up to four hours if it's not in direct sunlight or close to other sources of heat. Thawed, previously frozen breast milk can stay at room ...

You can carry your breastmilk safely in an insulated container with a freezer pack inside. A small bottle will even fit inside a wide-mouthed vacuum flask, with ice added to keep it cool. If the ...

If you are storing milk in your freezer and the freezer loses power keep the door closed as much as possible. This will keep the food inside safe for 24-48 hours. Milk that is still frozen or "slushy" can be re-frozen. Milk that is thawed but still ...

This method won't keep milk as fresh as a refrigerator, but it can extend its shelf life for a short period. Icebox or Cooler. Use an insulated container filled with ice to store milk. ...
