Ideally, you should look for a solar panel performance warranty with the following conditions: Some solar manufacturers will guarantee a degradation rate as low as 0.25% per year, and a performance warranty period of up to 30 years. The best solar companies offer homeowners an installation warranty of their own.

Take into account the warranty on your current inverter. Most manufacturers will only warranty their products for 5-10 years, so if yours is nearing the end of its warranty period, it's probably time to start shopping for a ...
