

How many bottles of water can be placed in the locker

Can you carry a bottle in a 100ml container?

Since the government has now asked airports that introduced the scanners to temporarily reintroduce the 100ml rule, for now, liquids must be in containers no bigger than 100ml but can remain inside hand luggage. Bottles larger than this will have to be thrown away. Heading on holiday and need new luggage?

How much liquid can you take in hand luggage?

There's a 100ml max rule for each liquid container you take in your hand luggage. Keep all your 100ml containers inside your hand baggage, you do not need to put them in a clear plastic bag. Bear in mind that all gels, pastes, lotions, liquid-solid mixtures (including food) and pressurised containers also count as liquids.

How do I take a 100ml container to the airport?

Clear bag: all your 100ml containers should fit comfortably in a clear, sealed plastic bag that's no bigger than 20cm x 20cm. Show security: you must take your bag out at the airport security point. During summer 2024, the rules around taking liquids and electronics through UK and Irish airport security have changed a few times.

Can a liquid go through security if a container is full?

Liquids in containers larger than 100ml generally cannot go through security even if the container is only part full. There are some exemptions. Check with the airport before you travel. Also check the rules at other airports you'll be travelling through - for example on your return journey.

Can you bring a full water bottle?

You won't be allowed to bring a full water bottle. Place the empty reusable water bottle in bin beside your bag, to make it easier for them to inspect. Put water bottles and containers with liquids, pastes, gels more than the allowed 100 ml (3.4 oz.) in your checked bag. Follow the 3-1-1 rule.

How do you carry a reusable water bottle on a plane?
