Push the ignition coil firmly against the flywheel and tighten the ignition coil mounting bolt. Remove the thickness gauge. SPECIFIED GAP: 0.4 ± 0.2 mm (0.016 ± 0.008 in) NOTE: Avoid the magnet part of the flywheel when adjusting. Adjust the gap equally at both ends of the ignition coil.
