Can You pressure wash a solar panel?

If you determine pressure washing can be done safely on your solar panel system, following these expert tips will help minimize any risks: Keep pressure below 1000 PSI and increase the distance between the wand and panels to at least 1-2 feet as pressure rises. Use wide fan-tip nozzles that are 15 degrees or greater.

Do solar panels need a pressure washer?

Remember, the goal is to maintain panel efficiency, not to cause harm through improper handling or cleaning methods. Selecting a low-pressure setting on the pressure washer is critical to prevent damage to the solar panels during cleaning.

How do you clean solar panels?

Then, use a squeegee or soft cloth to dry the panels, preventing water spots. I've learned it's best to never use high-pressure water as it might cause damage, which is why power washing should be off the table. Instead, treating the solar panels with the same care as washing a car ensures they remain in top condition.

Does rain clean solar panels?

Rain, in essence, is nature's way of washing and cleaning. It does a decent job in removing loose dust and light dirt from the solar panels. If your panels are installed at a steeper angle, the rainwater can more efficiently wash away the surface dust. However, the efficiency of rain as a cleaning agent is dependent on the nature of the dirt.
