How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Under Permitted Development Rights, you won't require formal permission to install a solar panel.

This will give the solar panel mounts a stable foundation, and will make sure they don't get damaged in stormy weather. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.
