

How many solar panels are installed at Warner Bros World Abu Dhabi?

Warner Bros. World Abu Dhabi: The Warner Bros. World Abu Dhabi solar rooftop PV project includes an estimated 16,000 solar modules placed across the theme park's roof area of 36,000 square metres and will produce nearly 40 per cent of its annual energy demand. The total installed capacity is 7MWp. The plant was inaugurated in March 2023.

How much does solar energy cost in Abu Dhabi?

Who owns Abu Dhabi's solar power plant?

TAQA owns 40 percent of the project, Masdar owns 20 percent while the remaining partners, EDF Renewables and Jinko Power, own a 20 percent stake each. The plant will supply power to the procurer EWEC - following the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) signed in 2020 - and will raise Abu Dhabi's solar power production capacity to 3.2GW.

How many MW of solar energy will be installed in the UAE?

Around 135 MW of solar energy production capacity is expected to be operational by the end of 2013, and a similar capacity is either operational or under construction outside the UAE borders. This adds to 40 MW of PV modules installed worldwide, and manufactured by the UAE owned manufacturer Masdar PV.
