Is installing solar panels illegal in any state?

Technically, no state outlaws or bans solar panels; quite the opposite. Most states have solar access laws that forbid any agreement, covenant, condition, bylaw, or contract that outlaws or limits solar installations by Homeowners Associations (HOA) or other municipal bodies.

Are solar access laws illegal?

With that being said, unpermitted systems are illegal to operate in many American jurisdictions, even in states with solar access laws. What is the difference between solar access laws and solar easement laws?

Do you need a license to install rooftop solar panels?

Some states, like Colorado and Idaho, allow homeowners to perform electrical work on their own homes without a license, but in most cases a permit is still required to install rooftop solar panels.

Does Pennsylvania have solar access laws?

Pennsylvania does not have any solar access laws. Although Rhode Island residents can create solar easements, there are no statewide solar access laws that HOAs must follow. There are no solar access laws that restrict HOA power in South Carolina. South Dakotans can establish solar easements, but there are not any access laws in place statewide.

Do I need a permit to install solar panels?

However, for more complex or large-scale solar projects, additional permits and approvals may be required. If you choose to install them on your own, it is essential to consult with local authorities or building departments to understand the specific permit requirements and procedures applicable to your solar installation project.
