

In recent years, the government in Laos has expanded solar, wind and biomass energy as part of its strategy to diversify energy sources and ensure energy security. Eight solar energy plants and four biomass power plants have been operating, with an installed generation capacity of 116 megawatts. But these plants contribute only 1% of the ...

China-based SolarSpace, a well-known solar cell vendor recently turned module maker, is unique in that it has built production capacity in Laos. The company's Corporate Vice President, James Hu, spoke about the rationale behind this move and the company's business strategy for the US market at RE+ 2024.

As of 2023, solar energy made up less than 1% of the energy mix. The Laotian government has set ambitious goals to diversify its renewable energy portfolio. By 2030, Laos aims to achieve a combined solar and wind capacity of 1 GW as part of a broader strategy to reduce dependence on hydropower and enhance energy security.

The solar farm, located near the Laos-China border, aligns with Laos's goal to increase renewable energy consumption to 30 percent by 2025. This initiative is part of the broader Northern Clean Energy Connection project, which aims to bolster energy security and support Laos's renewable energy development plan.

Lao Solar Site. About the project. Convalt Energy, a US based renewable energy company and operator started the development of this 250 MW AC Solar Power Project in Province of Attapeu, southern Lao P.D.R in South East Asia in 2016 which is in the final stages of development.

Laos is undergoing rapid socio-economic changes and the provision of sufficient energy is an important factor in the response to continuing development. “Given recent advances in solar energy in Laos, it has become clear that more and more local and foreign businesses are interested in investing in this field,” Daovong said.

EDL-GEN Lao Solar PV Park is a 100MW solar PV power project. It is planned in Vientiane (Viengchan) Capital, Laos. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the partially active stage.

A signing ceremony was held yesterday for the development of a floating solar power plant on the surface of the Nam Ngum 1 dam reservoir. The Floating Solar Power Project at Nam Ngum 1 will be a public-private partnership, with the Government of Laos holding a 20% share, while the private sector will hold 80% over a 25-year concession.
