Are photovoltaic solar panels safe?

Are solar panels leaching lead?

Lead is present in around 33% of the thin coating on top of copper conductors in PV modules, and concerns about lead leaching from solar panels are widespread. However, calculating the leaching potential is challenging.

Are solar PV installations notifiable?

To clarify, what is certain is that nearly all domestic electrical work is notifiable under Part P of the Building Regulations (see below) and a solar PV installation is nearly always notifiable electrical work.

What happens if a solar panel is installed incorrectly?
