Are Lynx cats vanishing from France?

Lynx kittens at the Parc de Sainte-Croix Zoo, in eastern France, July 3, 2021. PASCAL PARIS The elusive Eurasian lynx is at risk of vanishing completely from France, according to a study Monday, February 13, that called for urgent measures to boost the population of isolated wild cats.

Where do lynx live?

The largest and most active population demographically is in the Jura with a population of a hundred individuals (ONCFS, 2003). In the south of the mountains all the favorable forest habitats are occupied by lynx, the upper border (east) to the plain of Bresse (west) and Rhône (south).

Are lynx endangered in France?

Fully protected species in France. Endangered. The Lynx was present everywhere in France in the 15th century they then became extinct or rare in many regions of western Europe including France during the 19th and 20th century.

Where did the Lynx come from?

Today the Lynx is present again in France in the Alps, Jura and Vosges. The French alpine and Jura populations have their origins in the re-introductions made in Switzerland in the 70's. Actual French re-introductions were in the Vosges where there were 21 released, 12 males and 9 females, between 1983 and 1993.

What happened to Lynx in France?

The lynx, which disappeared in France in the early 20th century, was reintroduced in the 1970s, spreading through the Jura mountains along the French-Swiss border, where the majority of the population remains. Main threat is cars

of hare scarcity, relatively large home ranges appear to be characteristic of lynx in southern boreal forests. Lynx dispersal movements are similar to those reported from the taiga. However, only lynx in southern forests are known to make exploratory movements prior to dispersal. We speculate that such explorations may reflect

Summary: Most regions (9) in French Southern Territories lie in the Tundra climate zone (K&#246;ppen: Et). The mean average of annual temperatures range from a high of 26.9&#176;C (80.42&#176;F) in Juan De Nova Island to a low of 0.0&#176;C (0&#176;F) in Glorioso Islands.

On August 6, 1955, the territories were named French Southern and Antarctic Lands. The first series of stamps bearing the new name TERRES AUSTRALES ET ANTARCTIQUES FRAN&#199;AISES was released on October 17, 1955. The issue consisted of a 15-franc Madagascar stamp bearing the overprint of the new name of the islands.

The French Southern and Antarctic Territories -- Terres Australes et Antarctiques Fran&#231;aises (TAAF) -- form an overseas territory of France, established in 1955, that consists of several groups of islands in the

southern Indian Ocean and a sector of Antarctica (see maps) that is claimed by France. The Antarctic territory is called Ad&#233;lie Coast (Terre Ad&#233;lie).

The Carpathian lynx, *Lynx lynx carpathicus*, is the largest big cat in Europe. In France, having been reintroduced in the Vosges, or having returned to the Alps of its own accord, it remains under threat from poaching and road traffic.
