

When is sunrise & sunset in Mongolia?

The times for sunrise and sunset in Mongolia are significantly influenced by the high location in the northern hemisphere. Relatively high in the north, the days are long in summer (June to September) and short in winter (December to March). With up to about 16:10 hours, there are the longest days in June.

Does Mongolia have a 10 MW solar farm?

Mongolia has connected a 10 MW solar farm to the grid, as part of a plan to deploy 40.5 MW of solar and wind capacity in the nation's western regions. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the government of Mongolia have inaugurated a 10 MW solar power plant in Mongolia's Govi-Altai province.

How long does a sunset last in Mongolia?

While a sunset near the equator lasts only about 20 minutes, in Mongolia, this period averages 43 minutes. In June, it's about 48 minutes in Ulaanbaatar, while in December it's 37 minutes. The capital Ulaanbaatar is located at 48 degrees north latitude and therefore also north of the Tropic.

When is December solstice in Mongolia?

Today is highlighted. The December solstice (winter solstice) in Mongolia is at 11:27 am on Friday, December 22, 2023. In terms of daylight, this day is 6 hours, 51 minutes shorter than the June solstice. In most locations north of the equator, the shortest day of the year is around this date. The earliest sunset is on December 10.

How much PV capacity does Mongolia have in 2022?
