



# Norfolk Island solar energy ria

Does Norfolk Island have too much solar energy?

That's pretty impressive given its remoteness and a population of 1,849. But this uptake has also caused some headaches in managing Norfolk Island's electricity network, with too much solar energy goodness generated at times. The Tesla battery system installed in December 2020 has helped out on that front.

This initiative is comprised of several interrelated elements: Project Background In 2022, the Commonwealth Government provided a \$5.25 million grant to Norfolk Island Regional Council to transition the island away from diesel-fired generation.

Will Australian government help Norfolk Island's diesel-based electricity cost woes?

The Australian Federal Government has stepped in to give the folks on Norfolk Island some relief from their diesel-based electricity generation cost woes. Norfolk Island is a tiny island (3,455 hectares) in the South Pacific Ocean.

Norfolk Island is transitioning to renewable energy solutions, using solar and batteries to lower the cost of electricity for all residents. As part of this process, every electricity meter must be replaced. In September 2023, we will begin this process in Burnt Pine and will gradually work our way around the island. What will this mean for you...

For homeowners in Norfolk planning to remain in their homes after the payback period for solar panels, solar energy is a sensible choice. In Norfolk, VA, a 5 kW solar system installation might save you \$20,930.6 on



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average over 20 years, with a typical break even point of 8 years. The cost of not having solar panels in Norfolk, VA

Incite Energy's electrical engineer, Matias Valdes and Director of Decarbonisation, Kody Ponds are working alongside Norfolk Island Regional Council to carry out commercial survey and design studies on Norfolk Island for the rollout of BESY Energy commercial solar for NIRC utilities, which will benefit the whole community.

This month, on average, solar systems installed on Norfolk Island produced 2.9kWh of energy per kW installed. Back in January, this average was 4.0kWh per kW. Current production is approximately 30% lower. With less solar production we are unable to turn off the diesel generators for as long each day.

The proposed solar farm is located on land north of Swaffham and south of Castle Acre, West Norfolk. The project will include a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) so that additional energy generated can be stored and released when needed. We are conducting ongoing land surveys and assessments.

**Project Description** In late 2021, Incite Energy were appointed to review the operations and systems within the Norfolk Island Regional Council (NIRC) electricity business unit (NI Electricity) and implement changes to transition the island to an electricity grid dominated by renewable energy, allowing electricity tariffs to be reduced.

Energy experts often point to so-called "duck curves" in the California market and in Queensland, due to the growth of solar, but Norfolk Island is well ahead - in fact, it is already dealing with the excess of solar output over demand that is predicted for South Australia, Western Australia and Tasmania in the next 10 years.
