

The current Pitcairn Island dependency ratio (those under 18 and over 65 compared to the productive population) stands at 58 percent. The issue for Pitcairn Islands is that the ratio is trending in the wrong direction and by 2025 it will be over 100 percent. At this point there will be more pensioners than productive-age persons.

The history of the Pitcairn Islands begins with the settlement of the islands by Polynesians in the 11th century. The Polynesians established a culture that flourished for four centuries and then vanished. Pitcairn was settled again in 1790 by a group of British mutineers on HMS Bounty and Tahitians. Adamstown is named for the last

surviving mutineer, John Adams.

The full history of both the earlier Polynesian community and of the Bounty settlers will never be completely known.[See "Pre-Mutineer History"] Differing theories and contradicting stories concerning the events that took place after the mutineers arrived at Pitcairn, have been told.

In 1790, nine of the mutineers from the British naval vessel HMS Bounty, along with the native Tahitian men and women who were with them (six men, 11 women, and a baby girl), settled on Pitcairn Island and set fire to the Bounty.
