Will Australia expand the Heard & McDonald Island Marine Reserve?

The Australian Government is proposing to expand the Heard and McDonald Island (HIMI) Marine Reserve by over 300,000 km<sup>2</sup> to around 379,000 km<sup>2</sup>. The expanded reserve would cover nearly 90 per cent of the Exclusive Economic Zone around the islands and bring the proportion of Australian waters protected through marine reserves to 51 per cent.

What is the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve?

The Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve Management Plan 2014-2024 is due for its 10-year statutory review.

When is public consultation on the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve open?

Public consultation on the proposal to expand the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve and proposal to prepare a draft management plan for the reserve was open from 5 July 2024 to 5 September 2024. The public comment period has now closed.

Will the government quadruple Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve?

The Pew Charitable Trusts' national oceans manager, Fiona Maxwell, said: "We welcome the government's decision to quadruple the size of Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve and to expand fully protected sanctuary zones within the park."

At Heard Island and McDonald Islands (HIMI), there are no trees or ferns and the most advanced vascular plants are low-growing herbaceous flowering plants. The vascular flora on Heard Island is the smallest of any major subantarctic island group, reflecting the island's isolation, limited ice-free area and severe climate.

Heard Island and McDonald Islands are located in the Southern Ocean, approximately 1,700 km from the Antarctic continent and 4,100 km south-west of Perth. As the only volcanically active subantarctic islands they "open a window into the earth", thus providing the opportunity to observe ongoing geomorphic processes and glacial dynamics. ...

The nearest landmass to the Heard and McDonald Islands is Kerguelen Island, part of the French Southern and Antarctic Territories, 450 kilometers to the northwest. Mawson Volcano on Heard Island holds another record: it is the only known permanently active volcano in the subarctic region of the earth.

Heard Island and McDonald Islands (HIMI) are surface exposures of the second largest submarine plateau in the world, the Kerguelen Plateau. The Kerguelen Plateau is approximately 2 million square kilometres in area, and stands around 3,000 metres above the surrounding sea floor. ...
