Here is an actual photo of a Haitian power outlet. In Haiti, the power plugs and sockets are type A and B. Type A sockets are ungrounded plugs with two flat parallel prongs, which is standard for most of North and Central America. Type B is similar but also has a U-shaped pin, which grounds the device. Type B's socket also works with plug A.
