In a steady-state controlled environment, the experimental results show that the measured voltage, current and its power decrease with time as the temperature of the photovoltaic panel increases. As a result, the efficiency of the photovoltaic module will decrease progressively.

Do photovoltaic power plants affect air temperature?

The effect of photovoltaic power plants on air temperature in the land is also studied. However, the impact of the temperature difference between land and lake on the power generation is less based on field surveys, and the impact in this part needs to be further researched.

How does temperature affect PV power generation?

Considering from the perspective of light, the increase in temperature is beneficial to PV power generation, because it will increase the free electron-hole pairs (i.e., carriers) generated by the PV effect in the cell to a certain extent.
