

Is the Western Sahara conflict over?

Western Sahara's conflict is over. Negotiating the terms comes next. France's recognition of Moroccan sovereignty is a decisive step toward ending the Western Sahara conflict. International acceptance is growing for Moroccan control of the territory.

Why did Morocco eject Mauritania from the Western Sahara?

For its part, the Western Saharan nationalist movement received extensive support from Algeria and other influential members of the Non-Aligned Movement. This aid allowed Polisario to quickly eject Mauritania from the territory. Nevertheless Moroccan forces successfully ensconced themselves behind a that bisects the territory to this day.

Is Western Sahara still a comatose peace process?

With the UN Security Council continually focused on more pressing crises,the Western Sahara issue has faded,barely keeping the comatose peace process on life support. The fifth in a series of UN envoys attempted to visit Moroccan occupied Western Sahara for the first time in July 2022 only to be by Rabat.

Is Western Sahara a self governing territory?

Previously occupied by Spain as the Spanish Sahara until 1975,Western Sahara has been on the United Nations list of non-self-governing territoriessince 1963 after a Moroccan demand. [clarification needed]In 1965,the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution on Western Sahara,asking Spain to decolonize the territory.

What is the economy of Western Sahara?

Western Sahara's economy is based almost entirely on fishing,which employs two-thirds of its workforce,with mining,agriculture and tourism providing modest additional income. Most food for the urban population comes from Morocco.
