Do Puerto Rican government officials want answers from private electric companies?

(AP Photo/Alejandro Granadillo) SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico (AP) -- A growing number of Puerto Rican government officials on Thursday demanded answers from two private electric companies as the U.S. territory struggles with persistent power outages.

Does Luma energy have a power grid in Puerto Rico?

The contract under which LUMA Energy operates the power grid in Puerto Rico was signed after a bid in 2020. In the bid, five different companies participated and only four submitted business proposals. The \$1,500M contract is set to last for 15 years and can be renewed if both parties agree.

Why did the Puerto Rico electric power authority privatize its operations?

Both companies were contracted after Puerto Rico's Electric Power Authority privatized operations as it struggles to restructure a more than \$9 billion debt load and tries to modernize aging infrastructure dating from the mid-20th century whose maintenance was long neglected.

How much does electricity cost in Puerto Rico?

The base electricity cost per kilowatt-hour in Puerto Rico for a residential customer is \$0.04944 for the first 425 kWh consumed, and \$0.05564 per kWh after 425 kWh of consumption, with a base fee of \$4 which is independent of consumption. Where the majority of the cost in energy comes is in the fuel charge and energy purchase clauses.

What happened to Puerto Rico's electric grid after Hurricane Maria?

The outages came just weeks after Tropical Storm Ernesto swiped past the island and left more than 730,000 clients without power. Crews are still making permanent repairs to the island's electric grid after Hurricane Maria razed it in September 2017 as a powerful Category 4 storm.

How has Luma impacted Puerto Rico?

With the scope of our national project, LUMA's modernization and operation of Puerto Rico's electrical system has provided for the employment of 4,000 people. This has directly benefitted local communities and economic development, as Puerto Rico continues to rebuild from the damage done by the hurricanes of 2017.
