Warning people that the danger was not over and to remain inside shelters, Energy Minister Herman Halushchenko said in a social media post that Ukraine's energy sector was "under massive attack" once again.

How many times has Russia attacked Ukraine's energy plants?

The attack was the eighth large-scale one targeting Ukraine's energy facilities this year, DTEK said in a statement, adding that its plants had been attacked more than 190 times since the start of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine in February 2022.
