Approximately 250 kilometres (160 mi) east of Puerto Rico and the nearer Virgin Islands, St. Barth & lemy lies immediately southeast of the islands of Saint Martin and Anguilla. St. Barth & lemy is separated from Saint Martin by the Saint-Barth & lemy Channel. It lies northeast of Saba and St Eustatius, and north of St Kitts.
