US-based investment giant BlackRock has acquired Akaysha Energy, an Australian firm that has more than 1GW of energy storage capacity in its portfolio. The financial details of the deal have not been disclosed. BlackRock has committed to investing more than A\$1bn (\$700m) to support the development of battery storage assets in Australia.

Akaysha Energy's portfolio comprises nine battery storage assets, including Ulinda Park, a 150MW/300MWh battery project located in the west of Brisbane. The 2-hour duration project, which has seen AU\$200 million (US\$131 million) allocated towards its development, is set to commence commercial operations in 2026.
