

Does Saint Pierre and Miquelon have a football team?

Saint Pierre and Miquelon has a domestic football league comprising three teams. Starting in 2018, local clubs have competed in France's domestic knockout cup, the Coupe de France. Does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have a health care system?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.

Are Saint-Pierre & Miquelon a country?

The islands are a well-known separate country-level entity among many radio amateurs, identifiable with ITU prefix "FP". Those visiting, mainly from the US, activate Saint-Pierre and Miquelon every year on amateur frequencies.

How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.

How many radio stations are in Saint-Pierre & Miquelon?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have four radio stations; all stations operate on the FM band, with the last stations converted from the AM band in 2004. Three of the stations are on Saint-Pierre, two of which are owned by Outre-Mer 1ère, along with one 1ère station on Miquelon. At night, these stations broadcast France-Inter.

The commune of Saint-Pierre is made up of the island of Saint-Pierre proper and several nearby smaller islands, such as L'Île-aux-Marins. Although containing nearly 90% of the inhabitants of Saint Pierre and Miquelon, the commune of Saint-Pierre is considerably smaller in terms of area than the commune of Miquelon-Langlade, which lies to its northwest on Miquelon Island.

Air Saint-Pierre has flights to Saint-Pierre from Montreal, St. John's, Halifax, Quebec's Magdalen Islands, Miquelon and Paris. Many people drive to Fortune, Newfoundland, and take the passenger ferry with SPM Ferries. You don't need a vehicle, as downtown Saint-Pierre is walkable and there are many guided tours. Bring your passport.

Over the centuries, St. Pierre and Miquelon have experienced periods of prosperity and hardship, shaping the islands into the captivating destination they are today. Getting to St. Pierre and Miquelon may require a bit more effort compared to other destinations, but the journey is part of the adventure.

The national airline of St. Pierre and Miquelon is Air Saint-Pierre, and at this time no other airline serves this route. Long-haul international flights connect with the bigger carriers in Halifax or Montreal, and the most common route is from St. John's, the capital city of Newfoundland.
