Does Samoa have a solar power station?

MPower was awarded a contract to deliver a fully operational 5.0MW solar power station across two sites in Samoa. The first site at Faleolo International airport has a 3MWp solar PV ground mount system. The second site at Faleata Race Track has a 2MWp solar PV group mount system.

What is solar for Samoa?

The Solar for Samoa project set the benchmark for quality solar power projects in the South Pacific. The two sites will provide up to 27% of the network power during peak output. MPower has successfully delivered a wide range of renewable and conventional power systems across the region.

What is the standard voltage in Samoa?

Samoa's standard voltage is 230 V, while the standard frequency is 50 Hz. Travelers from countries with a standard voltage between 220 V and 240 V, such as Australia, the UK, Europe, Africa, and most parts of Asia, can use electric appliances in Samoa without a voltage converter.

The installation of Samoa''s 546kWp solar PV grid-connected system is expected to provide significant benefits to the government of Samoa by reducing the use of diesel by around 190,000 litres p.a and realizing costs savings of approximately SAT570,000 per annum in a country which generates 60% of its electricity from diesel.
