How many solar installations are completed under PM Surya Ghar muft Bijli Yojana?

New Delhi: Around 1.45 crore registrations have been made under the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana and 6.34 lakh installations completed, Parliament was informed Tuesday. PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana targets to achieve 1 crore rooftop solar installations in residential sector by FY27 with an outlay of Rs 75,021 crore.

What is pm Surya Ghar muft Bijli Yojana?

The Government of India has approved the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana on 29th February, 2024 to increase the share of solar rooftop capacity and empower residential households to generate their own electricity. The scheme has an outlay of Rs 75,021 crore and is to be implemented till FY 2026-27.

NHPC has invited bids to install rooftop solar projects of a cumulative capacity of 7,684 kW on its buildings under PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana.. The last date to submit the bids is October 29, 2024. Bids will be opened on November 6. The engineering, procurement, and construction of the projects must be completed in nine months.
