

Slovenia solar panel government scheme apply online

What is the Slovenian energy policy?

The purpose of the measure is to accelerate the deployment of investments in renewable energy production and energy storage, with the aim to foster the transition to a net-zero economy. The European Commission has approved a EUR150 million Slovenian scheme to support the rollout of renewable energy and heat as well as energy storage, in line with the Green Deal Industrial Plan.

How to invest in the renewables sector in Slovenia?

Investment in the renewables sector has been dependent on the availability of financing mechanisms. The Slovenian Energy Agency is the competent authority for tenders for the feed-in support scheme. Power plant operators, awarded by public tender, may choose between guaranteed purchase and operating premium.

Do solar power plants need a building permit in Slovenia?

Solar power plants with the maximum power of up to 1MW are,according to the Decree,considered small power plants and do not require a building permitto be installed. The Decree simplifies investing in renewables and is a welcome change as procedures for obtaining building permits in Slovenia can be time-consuming. 3.

Is the Slovenian scheme in line with the temporary crisis & Transition framework?

The Commission found that the Slovenian scheme is in linewith the conditions set out in the Temporary Crisis and Transition Framework. In particular, the aid (i) will be granted on the basis of a scheme with an estimated capacity volume and budget; and (ii) will be granted no later than 31 December 2025.
