



Solar power generation companies go bankrupt

What if SunPower goes bankrupt?

Other groups will be able to submit bids during the bankruptcy process. SunPower acquired Blue Raven in 2021 for \$145 million in cash, meaning the \$45 million lowest bid would be a shocking decrease in the company's value. SunPower also plans to sell other assets during the bankruptcy process.

Did solar installer file for bankruptcy?

Will SunPower sell assets during bankruptcy?

SunPower also plans to sell other assets during the bankruptcy process. For Complete Solaria, the SunPower asset purchase would be its second major acquisition of the year, following its purchase of Core Energy in July.
