Will the British Army power a solar farm?

The British Army is set to power one of its training bases with a solar farm for the first time. The Defence School of Transport (DST), in East Yorkshire, is the first of four pilots using the photovoltaic facility, the Ministry of Defence (MoD) said. A third of DST's electricity needs is predicted to be supplied by the farm.

How many solar farms will the Army have?

The Army hopes to set up 80 further solar farms across its estate in the next seven years. The Defence School of Transport is the first of four pilot sites to generate its own energy.
