

Should we expand the Heard and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve?

The public is being urged to have input on plans to expand the Heard and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve. The islands are located in the Southern Ocean, about 4,000 kilometres south-west of Western Australia, and are the only volcanically active islands in the sub-Antarctic.

What is the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve?

One of the world's largest highly protected IUCN category 1A marine reserves the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve was established by Australia in the waters surrounding HIMI in 2002.

Where are the Heard and McDonald Islands?

The Heard and McDonald Islands are 1,700 km from Antarctica and 4,100 km southwest of Perth. The Southern Ocean island group is one of Australia's most isolated territories. The islands are home to unique biodiversity including penguins, seals and seabirds.

How big is the Heard & McDonald Islands protected zone?

This week, the Government announced it was expanding the Heard and McDonald Islands protected zone, quadrupling the size of the marine park by an additional 310,000 square km-- an area larger than New Zealand. The Government said it consulted with scientific and fishing industry representatives on the changes.

Who discovered the McDonald Islands?

He reported the discovery one month later and had the island named after him. [11] His wife Fidelia Heard provided the first written description and drawings of the island. [12] [13] William McDonald aboard the Samarang discovered the nearby McDonald Islands six weeks later, on 4 January 1854.

How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km² (144 sq mi) and it has 101.9 km (63 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century, the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

Named after individual people: Captain John Heard, American sealer who sighted the island on 25 November 1853 & Captain William McDonald, who discovered the McDonald Islands close to Heard Island six weeks later, on 4 January 1854

Heard Island is 43 km long and 21 km wide. McDonald Islands are a group of uninhabited rocky islets, 40 km west of Heard Island (Encyclopaedia Britannica 2006). Heard Island has approximately 362.5 km² of area and the McDonald Island, 2.6 km². The site includes the adjacent offshore rocks and shoals and all territorial
