

Is Romania a good country for solar energy?

Romania is a country with great potential for solar energy. With 210 sunny days a year and recorded solar energy flux of over 1,100 kWh/m<sup>2</sup> /year annually, this makes a large portion of Romania's land solar feasible.

How much solar power does Satu Mare generate a year?

One of the most important solar projects was the installation of a 30 kW solar panel on the roof of the Politehnica University of Bucharest that is capable of producing 60 MWh of electricity per year.
