Wallis and Futuna comprises two archipelagoes: Hoorn Islands group (also known as the Futuna Islands, and as 'les Horne). Futuna Island (pop.~5,000); Alofi Island (uninhabited) Alofi Island is the smaller of the two. According to legend it was as densely inhabited as Futuna up until the 19th century, when the Futuna people slaughtered and ate the population in a single raid.

The first humans settled Wallis and Futuna around 800 B.C. The islands were a natural midpoint between Fiji and Samoa. Around A.D. 1500, Tongans invaded Wallis and a chiefdom system resembling Tonga's formal hierarchy developed on the island. Tongans attempted to settle Futuna but were repeatedly rebuffed.
